“The Feasts of Tabernacles [Ingathering]” October 13th-October 20th @ 7:00 PM

FEAST OF TABERNACLES is one of the oldest and most joyous of the Hebrew holydays, called in the Bible the Feast of Ingathering and today often called by its Hebrew name, Sukkoth [Heb.,= booth]. The holyday begins on the 15th day of Tishri, the seventh month in the

Hebrew calendar, and lasts for eight days (seven days in Israel). The Feast of Tabernacles marked the closing of the harvest season. The importance of this festival is indicated by the statement, *“This is to be a lasting ordinance.”* The divine pronouncement, *“I am the Lord your God,”* concludes this section on the holydays of the seventh month. (Lev.23) It is a drastic change from one of the most solemn holydays in our year to one of the most joyous. The word Sukkoth means “booths,” and refers to the temporary dwellings that Hebrews are commanded to live in during this holyday, just as the Hebrews did in the wilderness.
